<u>Pick up Fish Thursday, April 25, 2024 at 12:30 p.m. at the Hocking County Fairgrounds in the parking lot behind the SWCD office 148 North Homer Ave.</u>

You will need to bring your own containers w/unscented trash bag, 1/3 full of your pond water & twist tie/twine; 5-gallon buckets are suitable.

General rule of thumb; one container per 100 small fish, one container per 1000 minnows, one container per 4-5 amurs.
